

Stay Safe Guidelines

Essential information for anyone who will be present at our B2B events 2022. Learn about our increased hygiene measures and medical safeguarding. (Event health and safety precautionary guidelines are subject to change as directed by Italian and Spanish authorities)

Before travelling

Please ensure you have taken the time to read all of the latest Government, Public Health, travel and testing guidance. For travel to Italy please click <u>here>></u> and for travel to Spain please click <u>here>></u>.

On Arrival

All attendees will need to demonstrate proof of COVID-19 status to check into the venue hotel and to enter the Workshop room. On arrival you will need to present a **text**, **email** or **pass** to verify your COVID status is one of the following:

- Proof of completion of a **full course of vaccination** (completed at least two weeks prior to arrival)
- Proof of a **negative Rapid Antigen Test** or **negative PCR** result taken **within 72 hours** of arrival
- Proof of **natural immunity** shown by a positive PCR test result for COVID-19, **lasting for 180 days from the date of the positive test** and following completion of the self-isolation period.

Please note that we will **not** accept **physical** rapid antigen test **strips** as a valid proof of status.
